CARE AND CLEANING GUIDE



Glacier features Cleangene technology. Cleangene is a stain inhibiting polymer inherent to the material make-up. Unlike topical treatments it does not wear off. Cleangene enables the use of strong cleaners such as undiluted Isopropyl Alcohol and high concentrations of bleach, and a variety of other industrial cleaners. With Cleangene, virtually any tough stain can be removed. Prompt cleaning is always recommended. Recommended cleaning steps are listed by type of stain. For best results follow cleaning steps in order.

REGULAR CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

Clean the soiled area with mild soap and water, then rinse with fresh water and wipe dry with a clean cloth.

EXAMPLE

Dust

FOOD STAINS / OILS

Wipe affected area with a soft cloth or soft bristle brush using a non-abrasive cleaner, for example Formula 409 or Fantastik. Rinse with fresh water and wipe dry.

Ketchup
Chocolate
Coffee
Tea
Juice

HEALTHCARE

Clean the soiled area with a 10% solution of Household Bleach and water. It is important to rinse the cleaned area with fresh water after applying the bleach solution.

Blood
Urine
Betadine
Disinfectant

DIFFICULT STAINS

Clean the soiled area with 70% solution of Isopropyl Alcohol (Rubbing Alcohol) and water. It is important to rinse the cleaned area with fresh water after applying the alcohol solution.

Eye shadow / Mascara
Lipstick
Crayon
Grease
Mustard
