Luxurious, durable, biodegradable, recyclable and renewable, wool is the natural green choice.









Inspired by the subtle hues of Scotland's landscape.

The Isle Mill – family owned for over 230 years.

With a history stretching back more than 230 years, the company founded by Alexander Macnaughton continues as one of the oldest family companies operating in Scotland.

Tracing its roots to the banks of Loch Tay in the Perthshire Highlands, Alexander set up a small spinning mill in 1783 to process his neighbours' wool. Fabric weaving soon followed, and as skills and craftmanship developed, so did the company's reputation for beautiful tweeds and tartans.

The Company is now headquartered in Perth to take advantage of the better communications that a city provides, but its heart, along with the weaving mill, remains in the Highlands. Although retaining many traditional skills, the company utilises modern and flexible manufacturing techniques; this allows The Isle Mill to provide its customers with efficient and prompt service.
